If everything is correct, there will be a link to confirm that your FAFSA is complete and correct. Once you confirm, your SAR will be sent to all the schools you listed on your FAFSA. Schools will then use this information to send you a financial award package. If you do not receive a Student Aid Report in the next two weeks, please call FAFSA at 1-800-4-FEDAID.
