SENIOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

TIM AND DANNY RENOLDS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: Tim and Danny were two special Canyon brothers who were tragically killed. Every year, their parents award a \$500 dollar scholarship to a senior male athlete in their honor. If you have a GPA between 2.5 and 3.5 and plan to go to go a trade school community college, or university, please pick up an application in the counseling office. The deadline for this scholarship is May 7th.

IS THERE A FINANCIAL HARDSHIP in your family that is making it difficult for you to attend college?
