NROTC Scholarship Meeting on October 25th in A-Lecture Hall from 12:30-1:00 pm.

The Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps is a scholarship that pays up to \$180,000 for school. It is intended for Seniors and Juniors the application process should begin in their junior year, as the recipients are notified in the fall and winter of their senior year. The applicants must achieve a score of 1000 on their SAT or a score of 22(combined math and verbal) on their ACT. The way it works is the individual will attend school from September to June and during the summer they will be doing Marine training. Last year LA County had 8 recipients, one of them being from here Santa Clarita.
