**ARE YOU A SENIOR AND YOU ARE APPLYING TO San Jose State?** Remember that since it is an impacted school they will decide admissions based on the A-G GPA and SAT/ACT scores. Make sure you have contacted either/or the College Board or ACT.org to have your test scores officially sent before **Thursday Dec. 22nd**. Also on-campus housing is required of all incoming freshmen who live further than 30-miles from the campus. Also, incoming students need to take their ELM/EPT tests asap, beginning in January and **if students need remedial classes they may take them at a CSU, like CSUN, for example, the summer of 2012**, before they begin their fall classes at San Jose State.
