CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION (CHSPE): The California High School Proficiency Examination will be administered on March 19, 2011. The registration deadline is February 18, 2011 and costs \$92.00. The late registration date is March 4 and will cost \$120. This exam is for students interested in an alternative to graduating from high school so they could move ahead to higher education or prepare for a career. You can earn the legal equivalent of a high school diploma by proving your proficiency in basic skills through the CHSPE exam. You must be 16 years old, or, if 15, must be in your last semester of 10th grade. See Mrs. Hettema in the Counseling Office for an application booklet. The next test date this year won't be until June 18, 2011.
