CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION (CHSPE): The California High School Proficiency Examination will be administered on Oct. 20, 2012. The emergency registration deadline is Oct. 16, 2012 and costs \$160.00. This exam is for students interested in an alternative to graduating from high school so they could move ahead to higher education or prepare for a career. You can earn the legal equivalent of a high school diploma by proving your proficiency in basic skills though the CHSPE exam. You must be 16-years old, or, if 15, must be in your last semester of 10th grade. See Mrs. Hettema in the Counseling Office for an application or apply online at www.chspe.net.
