SENIORS! Have you submitted a Cal Grant Verification form yet? If you are going to a **California** junior college, 4-year college, or a vocational school after high school and you're applying for financial aid, you need to come to the Counseling Office and fill out the CAL GRANT VERIFICATION form. It allows you to ask the state of California for FREE money to attend one of these programs. **YOU MUST** mail the form by Friday, March 2nd. **YEP! TODAY!** You need to fill the top of the form out in blue or black ink (requires student's Social Security #) and then you must ask your counselor to fill out the bottom part. Then you make a copy of it, and you take **THE ORIGINAL** to the post office, and mail it with a certificate of mailing. Do not delay! You and your parent must also complete the FAFSA online ASAP in order to apply for financial aid. GO TO: www.fafsa.ed.gov
