### INCOMING JUNIORS, SENIORS AND GRADUATING SENIORS!

College of the Canyons is now accepting applications for the summer term!! They are offering over 400 more sections than previous summer terms, so this is a great opportunity for incoming juniors, seniors and of course all graduating seniors.
