Dress Code Alert:

California High School Proficiency Examination (CHSPE): The California High School Proficiency Examination will be administered on **October 19, 2013**. The registration deadline is **September 20, 2013**, and the cost is \$110.00. This exam is for students interested in an alternative to graduating from high school so they could move ahead to higher education or prepare for a career. You can earn the legal equivalent of a high school diploma by proving your proficiency in basic skills through the CHSPE exam. You must be 16-years old, or if 15, just completed your 10th grade year.
