The registration deadline is **September 20**, **2013**, and the cost is \$110.00. This exam is for students interested in an alternative to graduating from high school so they could move ahead to higher education or prepare for a career. You can earn the legal equivalent of a high school diploma by proving your proficiency in basic skills though the CHSPE exam. You must be 16-years old, or if 15, just completed your 10th grade year.
