CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION (CHSPE): The California High School Proficiency Examination will be administered on **March 22, 2014**. The registration deadline is **February 21, 2014**, and the cost is \$110.00. This exam is for students interested in an alternative to graduating from high school so they could move ahead to higher education or prepare for a career. You can earn the legal equivalent of a high school diploma by proving your proficiency in basic skills through the CHSPE exam. You must be 16-years old, or if 15, just completed your 10th grade year.
