### Halloween Dress Guidelines for Canyon High School

2. No items may be worn which promote or portray the use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco (eg. No *Breaking Bad* Costumes)
3. No items may be worn which demean / insult/ make fun of any person or group based on ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion or political affiliation.
4. Excessively revealing and sexually suggestive costumes will not be allowed.
5. Weapons, real or fake, are prohibited at school.
6. Outfits that are excessively bloody or glorify violence are not permitted.
