OPERATION US: Permission slips for our March 6th presentation at Pine Tree are due to Ms. Mast in E3 by the end of lunch this Friday!

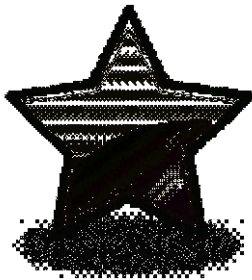
