The registration deadline is February 20, 2015, and the cost is \$110.00. This exam is for students interested in an alternative to graduating from high school so they can move ahead to higher education or prepare for a career. You can earn the legal equivalent of a high school diploma by proving your proficiency in basic skills through the CHSPE exam.
