This exam is for students interested in an alternative to graduating from high school so they can move ahead to higher education or prepare for a career. You can earn the legal equivalent of a high school diploma by proving your proficiency in basic skills through the CHSPE exam. You must be 16-years old, or if 15, just completed your 10th grade year.
